Too many highlights to mention, Lights leading the way averaging 331p/kg! topping at 355p/kg (£113.50-32kg) from WR & EJ Price, Llangynidr. 31.2kg Welsh Lambs from Caerphilly County Borough Council sold to £106.80 (342p/kg), and again at £105 (333p/kg), 29kg Welsh from HO Vicary & Son, Hafodyrynys to £96 (331p/kg). Numerous pens of Welsh lambs 315-330p/kg.

Standards were a pleasure to sell and a sublime trade. Again, too many highlights to mention, but the top 13 pens of Standards sold over 330p/kg. IE Cook & Son, Mynyddislwyn sold 36kg to £124.50 (346p/kg), GW & FM Jones, Llanfabon sold 39kg to £134.50 (345p/kg), The National History Museum, St Fagans sold 35kg to £119.80 (342p/kg) and C Ingham with 37.4kg Welsh lambs at £127 (340p/kg). Nearly all Standards 320p/kg plus except for a small handful not too far behind.

The Mediums 39-45kg also a very fast trade, W Edwards, Brecon selling a pen of 43kg Texel lambs to £149 (347p/kg), with 40kg Texel X lambs from T & D Merchant, Raglan to £135.50 (339p/kg). Again, plenty of these 320p/kg plus, most business done from 310-320p/kg, Welsh 295-310p/kg.

Heavies much sharper than we have seen and a very pleasing trade. No end of heavies 46-52kg 320p/kg plus and the majority 310-320p/kg. Top selling heavies at 334p/kg (£156.80-47kg) K Watkins & D Reed, Pontfaen. 50kg from GW & FM Jones, Llanfabon at £165.20 (330p/kg). All of those smart 46-48kg lambs £148-£155. 51-52kg lambs from £158-£165.

A good show of 230 store cattle selling to a tremendous trade and dearer on the week. All classes of cattle sharper with no less customers. Well fleshed types easiest to place and sold to £2700 (590kg) for a super Limousin cross from GW & J Hoggins, Whitecastle. Blonde crosses sold to £2660 (750kg) from AJ Heath, Llandenny. A tremendous consignment from DR & JM Pugh & Son, Llangorse sold to £2550 (600kg) & £2510 (545kg).

Younger sorts saw Charolais crosses sell to £2460 (580kg-17m) from MT & DR Watkins, Llantilio Pertholey. Top price per kilo of 512p/kg was achieved for Limousin crosses from Thomas Partners, Aberdare (330kg-£1690), with similar steers to 482p/kg (£171-0-355kg) from the same home. A well bred consignment from Penrhiwgarn Poultry Supplies, Llangynidr saw their best reach 475p/kg (£2120-446kg), 467p/kg (£1660-355kg) & 466p/kg (£1840-395kg) all from the same home. All the well bred types in excess of 450p/kg.

The Heifers were equally sought after and easily maintained recent high rates. Charolais crosses sold to £2490 (666kg) from GW & J Hoggins with similar heifers to £2420 (595kg) from the same home.

Blonde crosses to £2310 & £2280 (670kg & 630kg) respectively from AJ Heath. British Blue crosses to £2160 from VJ Price, Llancarfan.

Younger wintering types sold to 490p/kg (£1910-390kg) for smart Limousin crosses from Penrhiwgarn Poultry Supplies, with similar heifers to 469p/kg (£1900-405kg) from the same home.

EA Jones, Llanover sold their best to 467p/kg (£1750-375kg) for Limousin & Charolais cross heifers (17m).
