1. The Standard Rate of Delivery is Charged at £30 for the First 10km and £1 / km thereafter. Delivery charges are payable directly to the vendor.
2. WHERE DELIVERY IS OFFERED BY THE VENDOR, IT IS THE PURCHASERS RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE (PRIOR TO THE AUCTION) THAT THE VENDOR IS WILLING TO DELIVER IF OVER 15 MILES (24 Km)
3. The purchase price is payable to Monmouthshire Livestock Auctioneers upon the fall of the hammer. Fodder cannot be removed until payment has been received in Full (also allowing for the clearance of cheques).
4. Purchasers are advised to inspect each Lot and to have satisfied themselves as to the quality and quantity on offer.
5. The Auctioneers reserve the right to withdraw, subdivide or amalgamate any lots prior to or at the time of the sale.
6. All Lots are assumed to have been made in 2025 unless otherwise stated
7. The Vendor will co-operate as far as reasonably possible with interested parties as to the arrangement of viewings
8. Where Vendors have indicated that help with loading will be available, Purchasers must give the Vendor at least 24 hours' notice so that arrangements can be made.
9. The lots are to be taken with all faults and errors (if any) of description or otherwise. No misdescription or otherwise shall in any way annul the sale of any lot or in any way alter the purchase money. The Purchaser must satisfy themselves of each Lots description by prior inspection.
10. If the catalogue states an exact number of bales to be sold, it is the responsibility of the Purchaser to make his own arrangements with the Vendor to ensure that the numbers loaded are counted and agreed.
11. All Purchased lots must be totally cleared from the Vendors premises by Wednesday 24th December unless specifically stated otherwise. If the removal date is exceeded, ownership will revert back to the original Vendor with no reimbursement of the purchase price being made to the original Purchaser.
12. The clearance of each lot is the sole responsibility of the Purchaser who shall indemnify the Vendor for any damage caused during the removal or otherwise of any lot.
13. Insurance of each lot becomes the responsibility of the Purchaser from the fall of the hammer.
14. In the case of any dispute between Vendor and Purchaser, the Auctioneers decision will be final and binding.
