FINISHED HOGGETS

1069 hogs maintained their good form, SQQ 345p/kg for what would generally be considered a lesser show of hogs, with a majority of harder bred sorts.

Lightweights a very solid trade with most all well above 340p/kg. 32kg to £115 (359p/kg) from WR & AJ Morgan, Pyle and 30.5kg to £106.80 (350p/kg) from P Thomas & Son, Mynyddislwyn.

Those 32-39kg hogs were an exceptional trade again 36.2kg to £141 (390p/kg) from B Miles, Cwmcarnan. Numerous over 360p/kg including 35kg to £128.50 (367p/kg) from E Eynon, Llanvihangel Crucorney and 39kg to £141.80 (364p/kg) from HJ Powell, Bwlch. Plenty of 35-36g hogs £125-£132/head. 33kg up to £117.50 (356p/kg) from GR Isaac, Ynysybwll. 38-39kg generally £132-£142/head.

Medium weights to 363p/kg, 43kg Texel hogs to £156 from PM Parry, Gwehelog. 40kg to £140 (350p/kg) from MA Gwillim, Clytha and most trading from 335-350p/kg.

Those 46-48kg hogs were certainly in demand and many trading from £155-£160 and 330-340p/kg up to 347p/kg (£170-49kg) from DG Greenhill, Mitchel Troy. Super Heavies generally either side of £3/kg, with those 52-55kg generally £158-£165. A super pen of 53.5kg Beltex hogs from J Hopkins, Blaengarw flew to £195/head (364p/kg), which also topped the sale per head. Other hogs 64.5kg to £192 from EA & RE Bowyer, Llanbadoc and several through the £180's for hogs over 60kg.
