952 hogs to another very firm trade, with all weights very well bid for throughout, from 26kg up to 68kg, resulting in an SQQ of 360p/kg.

Lights to 390p/kg!! (£117-30kg) for Southdown hogs from H Wood, Glascoed and 389p/kg (£122-31.4kg) for Romneys from K Ruddle, Wells. Several Lights over 370p/kg, Welsh to 373p/kg (£104.50-28kg) from PE & SE Morris, Bedlinog. 26-28kg hogs generally 335-345p/kg, with those 30kg+ hogs just finding more favour.

Those 33-36kg hogs were a red hot trade. 33.5kg Texels to £128 (382p/kg) & 35.1kg to £134 (382p/kg) from PM Parry, Gwehelog. The smarter sorts generally over 370p/kg and any amount 355-365p/kg including the Welsh & Welsh X hogs. The 38-39kg hogs finding plenty of competition with 38.6kg Texel X hogs from JMD Bayliss, Trostrey selling at £146.20 (379p/kg). Again 355-365p would cover the majority of trading.

Sale toppers came in the Medium weights, a cracking pen of 43kg Beltex X hogs from K James, Bridgend, which sailed to £173 (4042p/kg). Other 40kg Texel hogs to £158 (395p/kg) from D & OA Prince, Llangwm and 41kg to £160 (390p/kg) from BB Farms, Penpergw. PM Parry again sold 41.3kg Texel X to £158.20 (383p/kg) with the best of a super run of shorn hogs from C Hinksman, Newport hitting 380p/kg (£159-41.8kg).

Heavies a very solid trade with those best 45-48kg hogs 350p/kg plus, with 46.1kg to £165 (358p/kg) from AG Thomas & Sons, Nash; 47kg to £167 (355p/kg) from C Guest, Woolaston and C Hinksman again with 45.7kg to £162.20 (355p/kg). The best Lowland bred heavies up to 52kg trading at 340-355p/kg, harder bred 325-340p/kg.
