### FINISHED LAMBS (9.30am)

1172, a much improved trade to average 302p/kg, the top 8 prices per kilo all 320p/kg plus, and top 6 per head all £170/head plus.

Lights showing a marked improvement with 33.5kg to £115 (343p/kg) from B & ZJ Lane, Llanvetherine, 32.5kg to £108.20 (333p/kg) from Bucks Buildings Ltd and 29.5kg to £94.80 from WE & CW Jones, Bayfield. Plenty of lights well over £3/kg including Welsh lambs from HO Vicary & Son, Hafodyrynys at 307p/kg (£87.50-28.5kg) and 303p/kg (£88-29kg) from WT Goddard, Bedlinog.

Standards also a very competitive trade. Bucks Buildings Ltd sold 36.2kg to £119.50 (330p/kg), PJ & S Edwards & Sons, Maesycoed sold 35kg Texel X lambs to £114 (326p/kg) and DJ Coonick, Tirphil with 38kg at £123.20 (324p/kg). Plenty trading over 310p/kg for those 34-38kg lambs with several buyers very busy on these weights, and the best Hill bred types still over 300p/kg.

Mediums equally as good to sell. SB Whistance, Llanvihangel Crucorney sold a superb 44.5kg Beltex X lamb to £150 (337p/kg). Any amount of those best types can be sold to a real premium. Plenty of lambs 305-315p/kg, just a few Hill bred or leaner 290-300p/kg. Most 40kg lambs £122-£125/head, with the 44-45kg lambs £134-£138/head.

Heavies a solid trade, but not seeing the lift as in the lighter lambs. SB Whistance again selling super Beltex X lambs to a premium with 47kg at £160 (340p/kg). The best heavies 300-313p/kg, the majority 285p-300p/kg. 50kg mostly £145-£155, depending on breed and finish, 46-48kg lambs £138-£145.

JM Grey, Pontyclun sold Texel ewe to £240 & £228, with MA Lean & Sons, Bridgend at £205. Suffolk X to £190 from MRI Whistance Ltd, Llanvihangel Crucorney. Those best lowland ewes mostly £160 plus, with most meated lowland breeds £135-£150. Plenty of big leaner ewes £110-£120.

Strong meated Welsh generally £105-£115, the majority of Welsh from £80-£95 for the medium sized types. Smaller/leaner £60-£80.

Tups to £162 for a Suffolk from RD Groucott. Several Welsh tups £120-£140. Goats to £138 from G Howells, Blaenavon.

The smart long term lambs £90-£105. Very long term £60-£80, with just a few very small Welsh £35-£50. Overall average £85/head.

A handful of breeding ewes saw Suffolk/Texel X Welsh yearling to £172 from EJ Jackson, Pontypool. 11 rams continue to sell to terrific demand. Texel yearlings from NG Arrowsmith, Glasbury sold to £830, £700 x2, £660 x 3. 2 year old Texels to £500 from GJ & M Price, Grosmont.

#### REARING CALVES (10am)

A short entry of 21 rearing calves forward selling to a strong trade and a large crowd of potential buyers. Huge demand for the best Continental calves selling to £900 for a British Blue cross from BE Baker & Son, Kemeys Commander. British Blue heifers to £840 from the same home.

A strong Consignment of British blue crosses from AR Edwards & Son, St Brides Wentloog saw their best reach £740 for a bull calf and £590 for a heifer calf.

#### WEANED CALVES

Stronger calves peaked at £890 for Blue cross bulls (4m), with heifers to £780 (2m) from AR Edwards & Son.

#### STIRKS/YOUNG STORES

A useful entry of 42 stirks following on from the Annual Sale on Monday this week. A superb trade was evident across the board, with many more cattle required to satisfy demand.

Steers topped at £1870 (390kg-479p/kg) for Limousin crosses from Williams Bros, Blackmill. MT John, Cefn Coed sold a super consignment to a top of £1680 (370kg-454p/kg). Simmental crosses from JW Cole, St Maughans reached £1610 (355kg-453p/kg). Top price per kilo of 498p/kg was achieved for Charolais crosses from PM Price, Merthyr Tydfil (£1220-245kg).

The heifers were equally as sought after and peaked at £1670 (350kg-477p/kg) for Limousin crosses from MT John, with similar heifers to £1400 and 462p/kg from the same home.

20 steers averaged £1472 & 444.38p/kg. 22 heifers averaged £1260 & 412.51p/kg.

## STORE CATTLE

### Auctioneer: Stephen Williams

An excellent show of 128 stores met an absolute flyer and around £100 per head dearer on the week. With numbers tight and the finished trade starting to rise the short keep sorts experience the biggest lift in demand.

Heavy weight steers to £2700 (710kg) for a British Blue cross from EJ Jones & Sons, Bridgend, with similar steers to £2600 (600kg) from the same home. A super run of Charolais crosses from FJ & MD Beaumont, Triley saw their best reach £2550 (650kg) & £2540 (635kg). MT & DR Watkins, Llantilio Pertholey saw their Charolais crosses reach £2480 (575kg) and 431p/kg.

Younger wintering types sold to 461p/kg (£1900-412kg) from TJ & D Llewellyn, Pentyrch. Williams Partners, Blackmill sold Charolais crosses to £1650 & 458p/kg.

A tremendous show of forward heifers saw Aberdeen Angus crosses from R Hayes, St Fagans sell to £2590 (710kg-365p/kg). AJ Heath, Llandenny sold Blonde crosses to £2490 (680kg-366p/kg) & £2450 (660kg-371p/kg).

Charolais crosses from FJ & MD Beaumont peaked at £2410 (590kg), £2350 (630kg), £2310 (640kg) for short keep sorts.

Wintering heifers peaked at £1780 & 473p/kg (377kg) from Williams Partners, Blackmill, with similar heifers to £1730 (390kg-444p/kg) from the same home. All the well bred types in excess of 400p/kg.
