PRIME LAMBS

584 lambs a real trade!! A great show of quality which helped no end, to level at 462p/kg, and many more could have been sold!

All weights in hot demand, topping at 487p/kg (£175.20-36kg) for Texel X lambs from JW Cole, St Maughans. Those standard weights commanding plenty of fierce competition. A Godwin, Hazelfield sold 34.8kg to £167.50 (481p/kg) and JW Cole again with 39kg to £186.50 (478p/kg). A tremendous amount of business done from 460-470p/kg.

As mentioned, a proper show of mediums topping at 484p/kg (£200-41.3kg) for Dutch Spotted lambs from JDR & JL Corbett, New House. Plenty of those smart 40-45kg lambs 470p/kg plus, with 40-41kg mostly £185-£190, a pen of 41.5kg Texel X lambs from PH Teague & Partner, Cefn Coch sailed to £196 (472p/kg). The heavier the lambs, the stronger the competition with buyers very active on weight & meat. Numerous pens of 44-45kg lambs from £205-£215/head. Top selling Heavies in terms of p/kg went to another superb show of lambs from CG Ball, Upper Cwm weighing 492kg and selling to £228 (463p/kg). The best of SE Gamble's outstanding run of lambs saw 50kg to £231 (461p/kg). Top of the day went to a pair of 53.6kg Texel lambs from Uskvale Pedigree which flew to an amazing £250/head, and purchased by MH Jaffer & Co Ltd, Gloucester.

The top 10 lamb prices per head were all over £220, with 98 heavies 45-52kg to average a whopping £219/head!! They really were a pleasure to sell and way out in front of yesterdays' trade. Meat is still King! There is not a deadweight quotation that could compete with this trade!

PRIME HOGGETS

A shorter entry of 583 hogs with Monday just having taken some of the numbers this week. Trade very buoyant throughout with all weights in demand provided they were GOOD MEAT! Leaner sorts are now difficult to place.

Lights to 417p/kg (£125-30kg) from IDJ & GR Whitcombe, Shalders Farm and a pen of Welsh hogs from HO Vicary & Son, Ty Oakley selling well at 416p/kg (£129-31kg). Several others just either side of £4/kg with most of these Welsh 30g hogs either side of £120/head.

Sale toppers at 454p/kg, a pen of 37kg shorn hogs from DM & PW Maddocks, which flew to £168! A pen of 37.5kg Welsh hogs from HL Hudd, Wauntyssg sold exceptionally well at £160 (427p/kg) and plenty of other 33-38kg Welsh & Welsh X hogs 410-425p/kg.

Mediums sold to 428p/kg for a bunch of 43kg Welsh hogs from EO Davies, Duffrynedd, which reached £184.20. those well finished 40-42kg hogs from £168-£176/head, and the 44-45kg hogs mostly £180-£192.

As in the lambs, weight & meat now coming to the fore, with the 45-52kg Heavies to average £195/head and the Super Heavies 52kg+ an incredible £215/head average for 146 sold, which would include a lot of Welsh tup hogs.

46-48kg hoggs regularly through the £190's, a pen of 46kg from RN Munro, Pontyclun selling to £191 (415p/kg). 50kg just either side of £200/head. I Holland, New House sold 50kg to £203.50 (407p/kg) for Welsh hoggs.

Top selling an outstanding £250/head (96kg) from JJ Greenow & Sons, Penyworlod and purchased by MH Jaffer & Co Ltd, Gloucester. The top 9 all £220/head plus, and top 18 prices £210/head plus for hoggs down to 55kg. Where else other than the Livestock Market will you sell hoggs for this money?!

Top selling ewes at £274/head went to a pen of 12 Texels from R & A Howells, Court Farm. Other strong Texel ewes at £260.50 from WG Davies & Son, Gelli Farm, and £248 from BG Greenow & Partner, Upper House. JDR & JL Corbett, New House Farm sold Dutch Spotted ewes to £260 & £228, with Beltex ewes from DE & SJ Cheaker, Ostbridge Manor hitting £245. Plenty of stronger Continental ewes £210-£230/head. Suffolk X ewes topped at £215 from AE Weaver & Son, Perrinpit Farm, several stronger Suffolks £200 plus and a bunch of 27 to £200 from R Gilder, Cumberwood Farm. Most of those stronger lowland ewes £185-£200, medium lowland £165-£185.

Hill bred ewes a superb trade particularly those 'festival spec' types which were extremely sought after. Cheviots to £189 from AT & PR Jones, High House; £180 from CLI Gatehouse & Son, Cae Cottrell. Welsh to £179 from BG Greenow & Partner, Upper House and a big bunch of 23 Cheviots from JT & GE Bowen & Co, Pencoedcae sold at the end of the sale, on the loading bays hit £175.50. Plenty of those strongest Welsh/Cheviot/Speckled at £160/head plus and any amount over £140 for the medium sized Hill types.

Smaller meated Hill ewes £115-£125, some big runs of plain Hill ewes in the entry, the best of these £90-£110, with several very lean £60-£80.

Rams a red hot trade! WG Davies & Son, Gelli Farm sold 2 Texels at £307/head! Texel X to £240 from JH Roberts, Pwllmair, and £228 from DR & JM Pugh & Son, Crickie. I Holland, New House sold a NC Cheviot to £225.50, with other Cheviots & Welsh to £206.50, again from JH Roberts. Plenty of stronger tups, including Welsh over £190/head.

STORE CATTLE

A good show of 170 store cattle with more style and flesh amongst the entry. Despite reports of dismal finished cattle returns, tighter number on a national basis is keeping store cattle prices buoyant in the live ring. Recent rain will ease the pressure on grazing ground and help to bulk crops as harvest gets underway.

Heavy weight Aberdeen Angus steers led the trade to £2520 (850kg) from R Hayes, St Fagans. Charolais crosses from DW Probert, Llanvihangel Crucorney sold to £2390 (655kg) with a super Limousin cross to £2310 (640kg) from DT & DSE Davies, Llanspyddid. All the heavy weight, short keep types in excess of £2100.

Grazing types continue to defy the trend selling to £2010 (495kg) for Limousin crosses from HP Griffiths, Court Colman. Messrs FE & VE Phillips, Walterstone sold Limousin crosses to £1950 (500kg). Top price per kilo of 451p/kg was achieved for Charolais crosses £1760 (390kg) from RD, DR & RS Heath, Llantilio Crossenny. Charolais crosses to 443p/kg (£1850-418p/kg) from H, JW & MH Evans, Plasycod. Good grazing types generally in excess of 400p/kg.

A good quality show of heifers saw Limousin crosses sell to £2160 (545kg) from D Jeremiah, Caerwent. DT & DSE Davies, Llanspyddid sold Limousin crosses to £2130 (640kg).

A good consignment of British Blue cross Friesian heifers from JR Williams, Whitson sold to £2020 (595kg), £1940 (545kg) & £1910 (565kg).

Grazing heifers to 405p/kg and £1700 for 420kg Charolais crosses from RD, DR & RS Heath, with Limousin crosses to 405p/kg from RA Cooper & RA Mandley, Llanveynoe (£1700-420kg). Well bred types all in excess of 370p/kg.
