

NORTH COUNTRY CHEVIOT SHOW & SALE – FRI. 28TH AUGUST

203 Females & 19 Rams forward for the 2026 Sale at Monmouthshire Livestock Centre.

The Sale kicked off with the Older Park ewes topping at 650gns & 600gns from Katy Davies & Dafydd Owen, Penybont, with another from the same home at 450gns. Ben & Brydon Baker sold the best of their pen to 550gns, with Jack & Katherine Muirhead selling to 450gns.

A big entry of Yearling ewes topped at a terrific 1000gns for the Show Champion, Lot 640 from R & AM Howell, Lundy, who was snapped up by S Reed, Blaenannech. Sam Pedrick produced another superb run of Yearling ewes, selling to 600gns twice. Buyers looking for some power looked to the pen of Spring Bank, with Mrs A Sandle selling their Caithness bred sheep at 600gns on 2 occasions. Ffloyd Lewis, Brynowen showed a pen of smart Allanshaws bred sheep and topped at 550gns, matched by Katy Davies & Dafydd Owen also at 550gns & 500gns.

The next draw down generally trading from 350-450gns, and quite a few 300-350gns for commercial types.

A smaller entry of ewe lambs this year, topping at 400gns for the 1st prize winner from K & PM Griffiths, Millards. The smarter ewe lambs which caught the eye trading from 250-350gns, Katy Davies & Dafydd Owen again selling to 350 & 300gns. Charlie Cave, Bryngwyn sold to 320gns and AT & PR Jones, Clytha to 300gns.

Some real highlights in the ram section. Jac George, Talley sold Shearlings to 1800gns, Katy Davies & Dafydd Owen to 1750gns and Rhys Davies, Maerdy at 1450gns for his 1st prize winner. Several buyers for Commercial tups at 500-800gns.

A smaller entry of Hill sheep on the year, affected by both weather & Bluetongue.

1st prize Aged ewe & Champion went to Cobie King, Rowleys, which sold at 280gns to GA Livestock, Suffolk.

Yearling ewes sold to 250 & 230gns from AT & PR Jones, Clytha, with ewe lambs to 100gns from Russ Jones, Cwmdy Flock.
