316 cull sheep to a very lively trade, ewes to average £141/head.

Texels to £250 from J Phillis, Crickhowell and £230 from R Davies, Tintern. Oxfords to £220 from E Morgan, Bargoed. The best Suffolks to £214.50 from DJ Williams, Croespenmaen, with several stronger lowland ewes £185-£200. Most medium sized meated lowland ewes £160-£180.

Hill bred all a very strong trade, topping at £185.50 for a Cheviot from MJ Knowles, Claverham, the same vendor selling other bunches of Speckles & Welsh to £156.50 & £156. Other Welsh to £160 from HD & L Richard, Pontneddfechan and numerous bunches of those stronger Hill ewes over £140. The very small/plain mostly £90-£110. Tups to £200 again from E Morgan, Bargoed. Most stronger tups £160-£180.

#### COUPLES

162 ewes with lambs at foot for the Spring Show & Sale. A great selection of both lowland and Hill bred sheep on offer and a very busy ringside of buyers in attendance. Trade generally wouldn't be as 'hot' as we have seen it in recent week, but certainly not without its highlights. MT & DR Watkins, Tredilion presented a super bunch of 3 year old Texel ewes with twins, achieving 2<sup>nd</sup> prize in the lowland class and selling to £395/outfit (£132/life), with singles from the same home at £360 (£180/life).

The stars of the Show were a superb bunch of Texel X ewes with strong single Charollais lambs from FJ & MD Beaumont, Triley, Judge Matthew Bevan placing them 1<sup>st</sup> in the Lowland Class and selling to a whopping £375/outfit (£187.50/life).

Third prize winners, a pen of 6 Suffolk Mule ewes (FM) with twin Texel lambs from MA Webber, Bishton sold at £165/life.

1<sup>st</sup> prize in the Hogg Class went to a smart bunch of Texel X hogs with Texel lambs from K Walker, Llanvihangel Crucorney selling to £310 (£155/life).

Beltex ewes with single lambs to £300 (£150/life) from RW & CS Richards, Craswall, with other strong singles to £280 (£140/life) from Willobank Produce, Barry. Those strongest singles generally £130/life plus, multiples £100-£120/life.

Welsh singles to £210 (£105/life) from DP Mantle, Llangynidr, with Aged Cheviot ewes with twins to £200 (£67/life) from DA Streeter, Rhigos.
