FINISHED LAMBS

A much improved entry of 1219 lambs with all of those best types well in excess of 310 p/kg and many well in front of 320 p/kg. Weight and meat continues to sell exceptionally well, with plenty of Super heavies 300 - 308 p/kg and coming to very pleasing money per head.

JC & ME Price & Son, Grosmont sold 60 kg to £181.50 (303 p/kg) and also topped the sale in £/ head . J & M Herring sold 55 kg at 308 p/kg (£169.20) with plenty of big lambs trading £160-£175.

The 45 - 52 kg heavies topped at 325p/kg (50 kg £162.50) from E Land Trellech Grange , and 317 p/kg (47 kg, £148.80) from Werfa farm, Rhigos, with a lot of trading 305 to 315p/kg and most 300 p/kg plus

Mediums to 232p/kg (40kg, £129) from M Pugh, Crickhowell; 320p/kg (41kg, £131.20) from JV & RJ Williams, Llanddewi Rhydderch,

Standards sold to 346p/kg (37 kg, £128) for some super Beltex lambs from SG Williams, Abergavenny. R D Kincaid, Risca sold Texel 35.5 kg lambs to 324p/kg (£115) with all those smarter sorts 300p/kg plus. Several large bunches of Welsh lambs 33-36 kg mostly trading 280 – 295p/kg.

Lights to 346p/kg on two occasions - 30 kg £103.80 from Werfa farm and 32 kg £110.80 from S Bell, Cwmcarnvan. SG Williams sold 31 kg to £105 (339p/kg) and HT Stephens, Penyaemawr with a bunch of 33 Charmoise x lambs at 321p /kg (30 kg, £96.20). Several bunches of Welsh just over the £3 per kilo mark but most to 280 – 295p/kg with just a few under this.
