FINISHED LAMBS

A short entry of 640 lambs with an SQQ of 292p/kg and a steady trade throughout. The best lambs well over £3/kg and some excellent prices achieved for those very smart types. Mrs PM Parry sold a superb bunch of 38kg Texel X lambs to £125 (329p/kg), next best per kilo in the Heavies with 52kg at £170/head (327p/kg), part of a super run of Texel X lambs from H, JW & MH Evans, Cwmffrwdoer. Next step down mostly 300-305p/kg across most weight ranges.

Lights to 293p/kg (£85-29kg) from R & M Waters, Ponthir and 292p/kg (£88-30.1kg) from ES & JS Huntley, Rhydyfelin.

35-39kg trade from £100-£117 for the lowland bred, Welsh lambs 33-35kg mostly £90-£100. Mediums to 302p/kg (£122.20-40.5kg) from The National History Museum, St Fagans. 44kg Suffolk lambs to 301p/kg (£132.50/head) from JN Turner & Sons, Machen. Most 40kgs from £117-£122, 44-45kg lambs from £130-£135.

The majority of the Heavies 290-300p/kg, with those 46-48kg lambs selling between £137 & £144.

Super Heavies a very pleasing trade. A superb run of well finished lambs from Phillips, Ffarmers saw 60.4kg to £180 (298p/kg), and again a bunch of 20 Texel lambs (62kg) at £174.80 from the same home.

Hill bred an exceptional trade, especially if 'good under', Cheviots to £134 from EL Hone, Deri, smaller/leaner 'good unders' £85-£100 and looking a very good price. Just a handful of very small or plain under £70. Rams to £260 & £200 from The National History Museum, St Fagans, both brought for breeding. Welsh to £105 from AB Stinchcombe, Llanellen.
